**CRIMESTOPPERS and Tulane University Announces an Increased  
Crimestoppers Award of up to \$10,000  
for Information in Sexual Assaults Cases**

Tulane University, working with Crimestoppers, has increased the reward seeking information leading to the arrest and indictment of the individual or individuals who committed sexual assaults against two of its students in the university area on Sept. 28 and Oct. 12.

Tulane has increased the original Crimestoppers award for information in these cases from \$2,500 to \$10,000.

The first sexual assault took place on September 28 on Freret Street across from Howard Tilton Library between the hours of 1:30 a.m. and 5:30 a.m. On Oct. 14 the New Orleans Police Department issued a request for the public's assistance in locating and identifying a person(s) wanted in connection with both the Sept. 28 sexual assault and another against a Tulane student that occurred in the uptown area in the early morning hours of Oct. 12. The suspect(s) in both cases has been identified as a Caucasian or Hispanic male possibly driving a dark colored SUV.
