

## Crimestopper's Tip Leads To The Identity Of A Suspect Wanted For Aggravated Burglary

New Orleans, LA - The New Orleans Police Department has issued an arrest warrant for 22-year-old Luhron Gorman of New Orleans, wanted in connection of an aggravated burglary that occurred February 19, 2010 at approximately 2:52 P.M., in the 6700 block of Catina Street.

According to investigators, the victim was inside of his home when two African-American males entered his residence through an open garage door. Once inside the suspects demanded money. The suspects stole two handguns and cash and fled on foot.

During the course of the investigation, Third District Detective Roger Caillouet received information from Crimestopper's of the identity of one of the suspects. Detective Caillouet conducted a photograph line-up of the suspect at which time Luhron Gorman was positively identified as one of the suspects responsible for the incident and secured an arrest warrant for Aggravated Burglary. Gorman also has an arrest warrant from The Jefferson Parish Sheriff's Office for Armed Robbery.
