

N.O. East bust yields drugs, guns and cash from Crimestoppers Tip

New Orleans, LA – A tip to Third District police led officers to a large stash of drugs, guns and cash in New Orleans East.

NOPD officers received the tip from Crimestoppers of illegal drug activity, according to NOPD spokeswoman Officer Hilal Williams, leading police to a home in the 7200 block of Camberley Street.

“After surveillance was conducted for a period of time,” said Williams, “officers obtained a search warrant. Officers executed the search warrant and found approximately one ounce of cocaine, 569.37 grams of marijuana, one bottle of liquid codeine and six handguns in the residence. The officers also located \$19,305.00 in United States currency.”

Police arrested Ryan Moret, 24, and booked him possession of narcotics while in possession of a firearm, possession with the intent to distribute narcotics, false representation of a schedule II substance to wit cocaine, possession of a schedule III substance to wit liquid codeine, and drug paraphernalia.
