Crimestopper's Tip Leads To The Arrest Of A Murder Suspect

New Orleans, LA –Members of The New Orleans Police Department have arrested 28-year-old Bryan Hill, wanted in connection with a murder that occurred January 17, 2007, in the 2000 block of Allen Street.

According to investigators, First District officers responded to a call of a “male shot” and, upon their arrival, found the victim lying on the sidewalk with multiple gunshot wounds to the body. Emergency medical technicians arrived on the scene and pronounced the victim dead.

As a result of the on-going investigation, Homicide Detective Winston Harbin positively identified Bryan Hill as the person responsible for the murder and obtained an arrest warrant.

Crimestopper's received information that the suspect, Bryan Hill was in an apartment in the 7700 block of Read Boulevard. Today at approximately 7:45 A.M., members of The New Orleans Police Department's Violent Offenders Warrant Squad and The United States Marshall's apprehended the suspect in the apartment without incident. Bryan Hill was transported to Lock-Up and booked with Murder.
